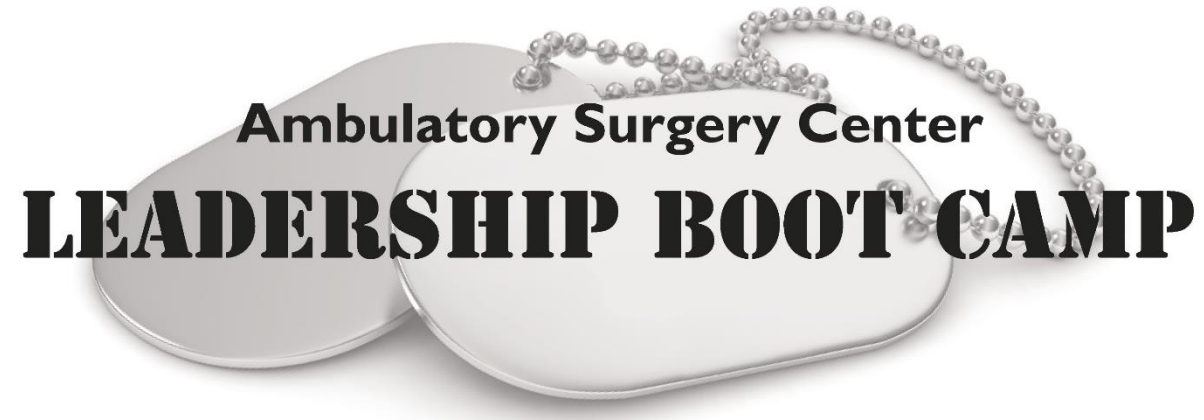

# Anesthesia

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Immediately before surgery, a Physician or anesthesiologist on the surgical team **examines** the patient to evaluate the risk of anesthesia.

The medical record should include that the medical discharge criteria were met.

Heart and Lung Assessment, and consent



To reflect the clinical record should include the patient was discharged in the company of a responsible adult unless exempted.

# Consents

What should an Anesthesia Exam and Consent contain and have occur.

Patient must have the opportunity to ask questions.

The Consent is good for 30 days.

If it's signed in the Providers office, review and initial.
